A Message from Rabbi Sandy Roth

Dear Friends,

The High Holy Day season is early based on our secular calendar, but they actually fall on the same dates according to the Hebrew calendar. Rosh Hashanah always falls on the 1st of Tishrei. So, what does that mean for each of us? It means that now, in the middle of summer, we once again begin the journey of *teshuva*. It is the time to reflect on the previous year and upon how we have succeeded and how we have failed. During the month of Elul, which begins August 11th, right through Yom Kippur, we “return” to our essential selves so that we might become human beings, better Jews.

The shofar beckons to us to bring our full capacity in awareness for who we have been and who we might be. We, as Jews, take this time of year to discover and develop our spiritual skills so that we might put into action the good intentions that we each have.

We all have the capacity to change, to improve, and to grow even though change is difficult for most of us. The charge at this time of year is: How will our lives be different, not indifferent?

Single Service/Holiday: \$140 per adult. \$25 per child ages 12 and under.

All Services/Holidays: \$225 per adult. \$50 per child ages 12 and under.

High Holy Day Tickets for Non-Members:

Single Service/Holiday: \$225 per adult. \$50 per child ages 12 and under.

All Services/Holidays: \$400 per adult. \$100 per child ages 12 and under.

Tashlich

The ritual of Tashlich, tossing our sins into a natural body of water, takes place after services on the first day of Rosh Hashanah this year. Congregants are encouraged to bring bread or bread crumbs, which are symbolic of our sins. We gather by the riverside in New Hope, and share in a short ritual. Tashlich does not occur on Shabbat or when it is raining

Break-The-Fast Information

We will be offering a Break-the-Fast at the conclusion of Yom Kippur Services. However, we need to have your RSVP and \$30 per adult, \$12 per child (12 and under) by **August 27** so we can make reservations with our caterer. (See attached reservation form)

Seating

Our volunteer ushers will be assisting KHN members to fill all available seats in the sanctuary on a first-come, first-seated basis. ***Please don't "save" seats whenever possible***-we have limited seating and wish to offer seats in the sanctuary to all KHN members who wish to worship (note: the sanctuary usually fills up by 10:00 am). As always, we will have overflow seating in the tent--downstairs and to the rear of the building--with sound/speakers. A Shul School classroom will also have seating and sound piped in.

As always, we strive to create a prayerful experience at Our Little Shul. While we welcome and enjoy the presence of small children in our sanctuary, we ask that you and your children leave the sanctuary if they are crying or are otherwise disruptive to our sacred space. Please also turn off all cell phones and other electronic devices. There is no eating or drinking permitted during services. Thank you for your cooperation.

Tallis/Tallit

All individuals who wear a Tallit are reminded to bring it with you to services, as the synagogue has a limited supply available in the lobby.

Yizkor

Yizkor is a time of remembrance and honoring of those loved ones who have passed away. Each year, during the Yizkor service on Yom Kippur, we read the names of those immediate family members (**parents, siblings, children, and spouses**) who have passed from this earthly existence.

It is also a tradition to make a donation in memory of your loved ones, as it says in many Yizkor services... "*Ehtain Tzedakah bah-ah-dah...* I will donate charity for her or his sake." We hope that you choose to carry on this tradition by making a contribution to Kehilat HaNahar in memory of your loved ones.

At the end of this packet you will find a form in which you can let us know the name of the departed **parent, sibling, child or spouse** you would like the Rabbi to read during the Yizkor services this Yom Kippur, 5771. If you would like to purchase a plaque on our Memorial Board, please use the attached form.

Please review the list of names to be read during Yizkor. If you do not need to make any changes, please check the appropriate box on the form or do nothing. If you need to make changes or additions, please fill in the form and return it by **August 27**.

9:00-10:15 am Family-friendly services in the sanctuary (children remain with parents)
10:15-12:00 pm Children's program in the classrooms downstairs
12:00 pm-12:30 pm Children rejoin parents in the sanctuary for the final aliyah.
12:30 pm – 2:00 pm Babysitting available in the classrooms (no additional cost; pack a lunch for children staying past 12:30)

Yom Kippur Saturday, September 18 (times are approximate) Cost \$10/member child*:

9:00-10:15 am Family-friendly services in the sanctuary (children remain with parents)
10:15-12:30 pm Children's program in the classrooms downstairs
12:30 pm – 2:00 pm Babysitting available in the classrooms (no additional cost; pack a lunch for children staying past 12:30)

- A responsible adult must accompany each child and sign him/her in to the Children's Program. Children will be escorted to the Sanctuary in time for the final aliyah. If you need to leave before that time, you must go downstairs and sign your child(ren) out.
- Youth 11 years and older are expected to be with their parent(s) in the sanctuary and not roaming around the Shul or participating in the Children's Program.

*The cost for the Children's Program is \$10 per member child, per holiday, which covers the cost of non-member program assistants and babysitters which are necessary to provide supervision to the significant number of children in attendance. A limited number of *Children's Guest Passes* are also available by advanced registration only on a first-come first-served basis @ \$25 per service. Please note on reservation form if a guest child is coming. **Forms must be received by August 27 for your child to attend.**
